



Places Of Interest

Stanley Park: Situated in Salisbury Rd. where Turitable Creek cascades over an ancient lava flow. BBQ, toilets, playground and tennis facilities. **Map: C6**

Macedon Regional Park: The large area on the summit of Mount Macedon is Macedon Regional Park. Picnic grounds are provided. **Map: C5**

Camels Hump: This is the highest point in the Macedon Ranges, with a lookout offering visitors spectacular views, and one of three local rocky outcrops formed by volcanic action millions of years ago. **Map: D4**

Kurana Memorial: Situated in the Cross Reserve to commemorate the DC3 "Kurana" aircraft disaster in 1948, this memorial recognises the 50th anniversary of the incident. **Map: C5**

Major Mitchell Lookout: To commemorate the naming on 30th December 1836 of Mount Macedon by Major Thomas Mitchell, Surveyor General of the Colony of NSW, the plaque erected at this lookout is located in the Memorial Cross Reserve. **Map: C5**

Trigonometry Cairn: Erected in 1853 and on the exit road from the Cross Reserve. All surveys in the district originated from this point. **Map: C4**

Memorial Cross: Erected on a vantage point with glorious views, the Cross commemorates those who gave their lives in the 1914 - 1918 war. 21 metres in height and 1001 metres above sea level, the original structure was unveiled in 1935, but due to storm and fire damage, it was replaced in 1995. **Map: C5**

Sanatorium Lake: This man-made lake, famous for its' intense reflection, was built to provide a water supply for a proposed Sanatorium for tuberculosis patients. The lake remains as a tranquil reminder. **Map: E4**

Private Gardens: Many gardens in Macedon and Mount Macedon are open to the public for the Victorian Open Garden Scheme for local organisations. **Map: D5**

Ash Wednesday Park: A leafy picturesque park that provides playground and BBQ facilities for visitors and locals and was born as a phoenix to commemorate Ash Wednesday Bushfires 1983. **Map: C7**

Centennial Park: A leafy picturesque park located at the intersection of Honour Avenue and Mt. Macedon Road, that provides BBQ and toilet facilities. View the stone statues depicting the area's history. **Map: D7**

- Enjoy the challenges of walking, running, cycling or horseback riding on the many trails in the Macedon Regional Park.
- Experience Anti-Gravity Hill.
- Visit the local monthly markets.

- Experience New Years Day and Australia Day horse racing, or picnic and enjoy the view at Hanging Rock, or from the top of Mt Macedon.
- Visit Victoria's best cool climate wineries and enjoy the food festivals.
- Experience 'Winter Art', concerts, galleries and workshops all year round.
